Bedford contains the beautiful Great Meadows National Wildlife Refuge with all sorts of animals. And the Concord River runs through it, along with the Shawsheen River. Hanscom Field Airport is in Bedford. Shopping in Bedford ranges from Whole Foods to Ocean State Job Lot. Bedford is fairly close to the Burlington Mall, although you need a car to get there.





